1.- IEEE-RITA

We continue working in the configuration of the ScholarOne, with the help of a person through the financial support of EdSoc. The ScholarOne is currently in testing phase, and we hope to be fully operative in the next months

It should be necessary to have a person at partial time serving as administrator of ScholarOne. We calculate that the cost of such person may be around 4,000 \$ by year.
