### **Report (June 15, 2018)**

**This report covers activity from October 2017 to June 2018**

#### 1.- Migration of IEEE-TLT

During the first months of this year 2018 we proceeded to the migration of the IEEE-TLT from the Computer Society website to that of our society, where it is already fully installed (<http://iee-edusociety.org/about/ieee-transactions-learning-technologies>). The most of the migration has been done, although some minor details still are pending.

The past April were launched the Call for EiC in TE and TLT (see both calls in the attached documents). The deadline for both calls is June 30. The EiC Search Committee of each publication is composed by the corresponding Steering Committee and the Vice President for Publications of Education Society, who chairs each EiC Committee.

The selection process is planned to finish at the end of next July.

A report to each of the outgoing Editors-in-Chief (Jeffrey E. Froyd and Peter Brusilovsky) summarizing their work during these years will be requested. At the same time, I take this opportunity to congratulate both for their excellent work developed during this time.
