

Walter Buchanan is a Past Thompson Endowed Chair Professor at Texas A&M. He has served in professorial and administrative positions at Northeastern University, Oregon Institute of Technology, Middle Tennessee State University, University of Central Florida, and Indiana University-Purdue University Indianapolis, was an electronics engineer for Naval Avionics, a Navy engineering officer, an aerospace engineer for the Boeing and Martin Companies, as well as an attorney for the Veteran's Administration.
